Athletes will also learn about opportunities to continue their study at an information seminar by Marina Meijer, Director at UStudy, a Vancouver based international education consultancy. Focus of the seminar will be on the education and varsity field hockey system in Canada and abroad, as well as the application process and funding opportunities.

This event provides Canadian players with a unique advantage in advancing their athletic and academic careers. Passionate players from anywhere in Canada are invited to attend the camp.

Saturday, May 16th to Monday, May 18th from 9 am - 5 pm each day.
